About the Artist

Ruth Rodgers works in soft pastels, acrylics, and oils. Her style is best described as 'naturalism' which seeks to represent reality not in the hyper-realistic way of photographic realism, but in the way that the human eye and brain actually perceive the world. She is influenced, as well, by the effects of light so well conveyed by the masters of Impressionism, and is also inspired by her immediate surroundings. Ruth hopes that her work will help viewers to see the beauty in the everyday world. She is the President of the Pastel Artists Canada, and teaches frequent pastel workshops at Meta4 Contemporary Craft Gallery in Port Perry, where her work is also displayed.
